The Blessed John Paul II Catholic Schools Network (JPII Catholic Schools) is committed to the safety of our students and staff. In times of emergency, due to weather or other unforeseen circumstance, school may be cancelled, delayed start, or dismissed early. The Superintendent will make this decision in collaboration with the other school districts and input from the National Weather Service.

When a decision is made affecting the school day, a message will be sent to parents and staff using the Emergency Notification System. This message will be sent to the primary number on file with the office. School announcements will be posted on the JPII Catholic Schools Network home page and in addition, will be aired on local television and radio networks.

If school is closed, all extra-curricular activities, practices, and non-school events will be cancelled.

Parents should plan ahead and discuss with their children what to do in the event of an emergency school closing. Working together will help ensure the safety and well-fare of our staff and students.
